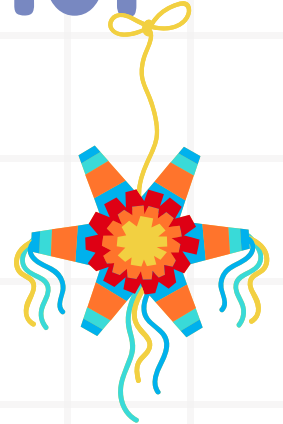

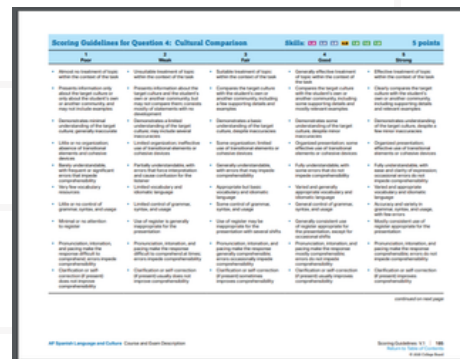

EVENTOS ESPONTÁNEOS

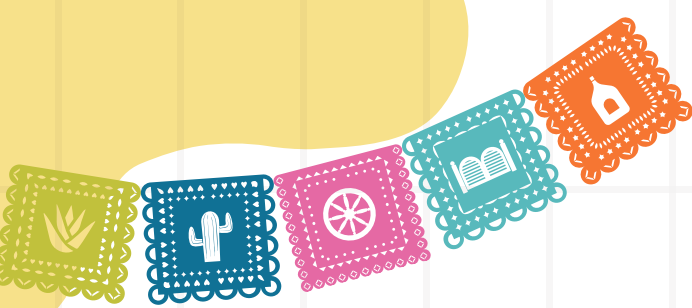
- Teacher must be a current member of AATSP Texas Brazos chapter
- Only students taught by that teacher are eligible to participate.
- Five(5) entries per school per event (individual events)
- Each student can participate in a maximum of two spontaneous events.



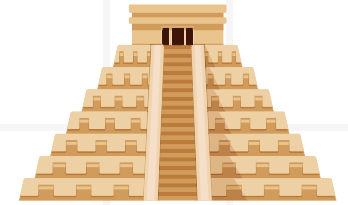
EVENTOS CULTURALES

- Teacher/SHH Sponsor must be current AATSP Texas Brazos Chapter member
- Individual or group up to 6 participants (any level : 1-6)
- Five (5) entries per event per school
- A student may participate in more than one performance event, but only One(1) may be a cultural display





EVENTOS CULTURALES



CULTURAL EVENTS (PREPARED EVENTS) are for all levels of Spanish Students from Exploratory to AP, native or nonnative speakers



Cultural Display (models, realia, diorama, artwork, poster board, etc) – must include written explanations in both Spanish and English

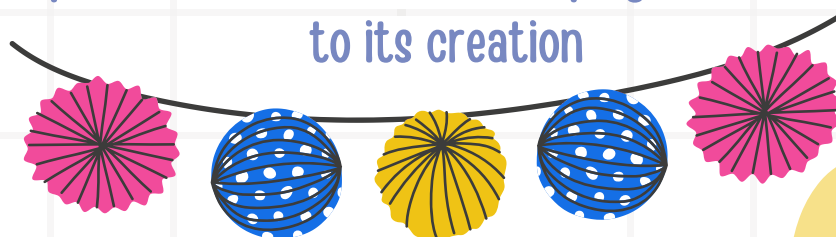
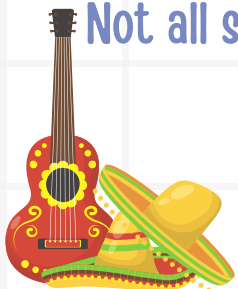
Cultural Performance (song, dance, skit/drama, poetry recitation, storytelling, etc) must include a brief written introduction explaining the relevance to Hispanic culture .



Entries may be individual or teams of up to six students from the same school, and can be mixed levels.

Note that for any given event a school may only have 5 entries total

Not all students need to be present for the cultural display but must be listed if they contributed to its creation



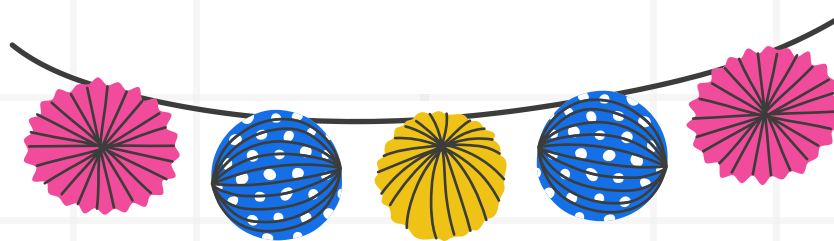
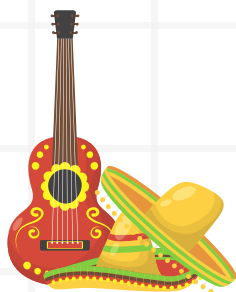
